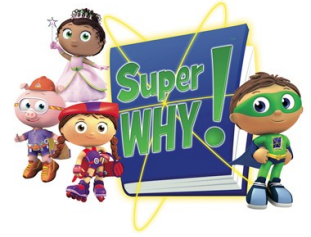

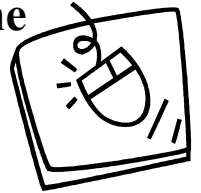

Program Highlights:

**Christian Values** - Our mission is to form disciples of Jesus Christ. We meet the needs of the spiritual, physical and emotional development of the child.

**Developmental**- We stress social skills, language, auditory development, fine and gross motor skills. We use themes to present our readiness skill practice, and structured centers to provide fun and excitement while learning.

**Personalized Attention**- Our three and four-year-old classes have a 6 to 1, and 8 to 1 adult-child ratio respectively. The licensed capacity is 54 children per session. Children are grouped by age according to requested schedules. Each class has a home-base as well as the opportunity to visit the varied center areas. Children work in small groups in our center areas.

**Parent Involvement**- Our program encourages a very productive and fun Parent

Group. You will find we support and foster Christian family life as well as stewardship opportunities.

### Moving up... Three-Year-Old to Four- Year-Old Program:

Families currently enrolled in GLDC will begin our registration process with the choice of all programs. The schedule of all programs along with tuition rates will be in the Christmas Goody Bag.

As you consider your program, think of your personal schedule and the best time for your child. You may want to take into consideration when your child's friends will be at school

**Four-Year-Old Program Orientation:** Parents and Child are invited to visit our four-year-old class on **Thursday, January 7<sup>th</sup> or Friday, January 8<sup>th</sup>**. The morning class will visit from 10:30 - 11:30 am, and our afternoon class will visit from 12:15 to 1:00 pm. During your visit you will meet our four-year-old class teachers and tour the center areas. The children will be invited to complete center projects. Children will have a snack as we answer your questions about next year's program.

We will fill classes as the registration forms are submitted. We hope to open our registration to new families by the end of January. **If you are registering a sibling, please schedule a visit the week of January 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, or 27<sup>th</sup> or attend the pre-school / elementary school Open House on Sunday, January 31<sup>st</sup> immediately following the Noon Mass,**

**Please remember our class space is limited, so do not delay.**

As you consider your program choice, think of your personal schedule and the best time for your child. It is especially important to note that we are a Catholic Christian Pre-school and our philosophy includes teaching the whole child. There is lots of love here at GLDC! We also support a lower adult/child ratio than is required by our state license.

The three and four-year-old children work together during the M to F afternoon sessions, as well as the T/Th full-day program. The teachers enjoy the children "teaching" each other, and working together as well as the smaller group activities that can result from moving into the center areas.

Our three and four-year-old program has an eight to one adult-child ratio, and in many classes less. Our licensed capacity for our rooms is 54 children per session. Children are placed in the classroom and groups according to the requested schedule. Each class has the opportunity to move to the center areas.
